21	request by filing them with the court, that approach is improper. Plaintiff must instead serve his	
22	discovery requests on defendants. <i>See</i> Fed. R. Civ. P. 30-36. Accordingly, it is hereby	
23	ORDERED that plaintiff's motion for discovery, ECF No. 32, is denied.
