The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 19 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302. 20 On September 7, 2021, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations herein 21 which were served on Plaintiff and which contained notice to Plaintiff that any objections to the 22 findings and recommendations were to be filed within fourteen days. (ECF No. 7.) Plaintiff has filed objections to the findings and recommendations. (ECF No. 8.) 23 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C) and Local Rule 304, this 24 25 court has conducted a <u>de novo</u> review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the 26 court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper 27 analysis. /// 28 1

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. The findings and recommendations filed September 7, 2021, (ECF No. 7), are adopted in full;
 - 2. Plaintiff's application to proceed in forma pauperis (ECF No. 2) is DENIED; and
- 3. Plaintiff is ordered to pay the \$402 filing fee within fourteen days from the date of service of this order and is warned that failure to do so will result in the dismissal of this action.
