BURKE, et al., 15 Defendants. 16 17 Plaintiff, a state prisoner proceeding pro se, has filed this civil rights action seeking relief under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States 18 19 Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302. 20 On April 25, 2023, the Magistrate Judge filed findings and recommendations 21 herein which were served on all parties and which contained notice to all parties that any objections to the findings and recommendations were to be filed within fourteen 22 23 days. The Court observes that this procedure is sufficient to constitute notice to the Plaintiff of the potential disqualification under 28 U.S.C. 1915(g) as required by 24 25 Andrews v. King, 398 F.3d 1113, 1120. Plaintiff has filed objections to the findings and recommendations. 26 27 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C) and Local Rule

¹ The fee for filing a civil rights action is \$402, which includes the \$350 filing fee and the \$52 administrative fee. See 28 U.S.C. § 1914(b). The \$52 administrative fee does not apply to persons granted in forma pauperis status under 28 U.S.C. § 1915. Plaintiff paid the \$350 filing fee on April 5, 2023. However, since his in forma pauperis status has been revoked, he must pay the \$52 administrative fee. See id. § 1914(b).
