12 Magistrate Judge Deborah Barnes for all further proceedings, and
13 any dates currently set in this reassigned case only are hereby
14 VACATED. Henceforth, the caption on documents filed in the
15 reassigned case shall be shown as 2:22-cv-00040 JAM-DB.

16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court make
17 appropriate adjustment in the assignment of civil cases to
18 compensate for this reassignment.
