considered the factors in Ferdik v. Bonzelet, 963 F.2d 1258, 1260 (9th Cir. 1992) the

1	Court finds that dismissal is appropriate. Given the significant time and resources that
2	have been devoted to this case, however, the Court will dismiss this action with
3	prejudice. As this was not the recommendation of the Magistrate Judge, the Court
4	issued an Order to Show Cause why the case should not be dismissed with prejudice.
5	(ECF No. 156.) Plaintiff did not file a response.
6	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:
7	1. The Findings and Recommendations of the Magistrate Judge (ECF No. 155)
8	are ADOPTED IN PART.
9	2. This action is DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE pursuant to Federal Ruel of Civil
10	Procedure 41(b).
11	3. The pending motions for summary judgment (ECF Nos. 135, 144) are
12	DENIED AS MOOT.
13	4. The Clerk of the Court is directed to close this case.
