


1 person who submits an affidavit . . . that [he] is unable to pay such fee or give security therefor.”
2 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a). The balance off plaintiff’s prisoner trust fund account shows that he is able
3 to pay the filing fee and costs. Thus, plaintiff has made an inadequate showing of indigency.
4 See, e.g., Olivares v. Marshall, 59 F.3d 109, 112 (9th Cir. 1995); Alexander v. Carson Adult High
5 Sch., 9 F.3d 1448, 1449 (9th Cir. 1993). Plaintiff will therefore be granted twenty-one days in
6 which to submit the appropriate filing fee to the Clerk of Court.

7 Plaintiff is cautioned that failure to pay the fee will result in a recommendation that the
8 application to proceed in forma pauperis be denied and the instant action be dismissed without
9 prejudice.

10 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, within twenty-one days from the date of
11 this order, plaintiff shall submit the appropriate filing fee.
