The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate 20 Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302. 21 On June 16, 2022, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations herein which 22 were served on all parties and which contained notice to all parties that any objections to the findings and recommendations were to be filed within fourteen days. (ECF No. 19.) Petitioner 23 24 has filed objections to the findings and recommendations. (ECF No. 20.) In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C) and Local Rule 304, this 25 26 Court has conducted a de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the 27 Court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper 28 analysis. 1

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 1. The Findings and Recommendations filed June 16, 2022 (ECF No. 19) are ADOPTED in full; 2. Respondent's Motion to Dismiss (ECF No. 11) is GRANTED and the Petition is DISMISSED with leave to amend; and Within 30 days from the date of this Order, Petitioner may file a petition 3. containing only exhausted claims.
