 16 **Whereas**, the parties filed a Joint Status Report on August 31, 2023 (ECF 28)  
 17 (“JSR”) that set forth proposed deadlines for completion of discovery and the filing of  
 18 dispositive motions for the Court’s Pretrial Scheduling Order. The Court, however, has  
 19 not issued any order regarding the dates proposed in the JSR.

21 **Whereas**, the parties have not filed any prior stipulations or motions to extend the  
 22 deadlines in the Court’s Pre-Trial Scheduling Order.

23 **Whereas**, although the parties have diligently prosecuted the action, a few  
 24 discovery matters have arisen that will need some additional time to complete for both  
 25 Plaintiffs and Defendants. At this time, the known discovery that remains to be completed


