17	Petitioner, a state prisoner proceeding pro se, has filed a petition for writ of habeas corpus	
18	pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254.	
19	On June 16, 2022, the undersigned recommended dismissing this case without prejudice	
20	based on petitioner's failure to submit an application to proceed in forma pauperis or pay the	
21	filing fee. ECF No. 18. The file reflects that petitioner has now paid the filing fee, and the	
22	Findings and Recommendations will therefore be withdrawn.	
23	Beyond identifying that the conviction at issue was rendered in Solano County, the	
24	petition provides no details to identify the conviction. ECF No. 5 at 1-2. Petitioner also fails to	
25	specify any grounds for relief in his petition and instead makes only vague references to an	
26	investigation showing his Fourteenth Amendment rights are being violated and conclusory	
27	assertions that he is being falsely imprisoned. Because the petition does not state any grounds for	
28	relief, petitioner will be given an opportunity to file an amended petition. The amended petition

1	should identify the conviction at issue and explain why he believes that his conviction or sentence	
2	is unconstitutional.	
3	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:	
4	1. The June 16, 2022 findings and recommendations (ECF No. 18) are WITHDRAWN.	
5	2. Petitioner's application for writ of habeas corpus does not state any grounds for relief	
6	and will not be served.	
7	3. Within thirty days of the service of this order, petitioner may file an amended petition.	
8	Any amended petition must bear the case number assigned to this action and the title "Amended	
9	Petition." Failure to file an amended petition will result in a recommendation that this action be	
10	dismissed without prejudice.	
11	4. The Clerk of the Court is directed to send petitioner the court's form for application for	
12	writ of habeas corpus.
