It appears that plaintiff has failed to comply with Local Rule 183(b), which requires that 19 a party appearing in propria persona inform the court of any address change. More than sixtythree days have passed since the court order was returned by the postal service, and plaintiff has 20 21 failed to notify the court of a current address. 22 Accordingly, it is hereby RECOMMENDED that this action be dismissed without 23 prejudice for failure to prosecute. See E.D. L.R. 183(b). 24 I submit these findings and recommendations to the district judge under 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Rule 304 of the Local Rules of Practice for the United States 25 26 District Court, Eastern District of California. The parties may, within 14 days of the service of 27 the findings and recommendations, file written objections to the findings and recommendations 28 with the court. Such objections should be captioned "Objections to Magistrate Judge's Findings

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1	and Recommendations." The district judge will review the findings and recommendations under
2	28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C).
