The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate 18 19 Judge pursuant to Eastern District of California local rules. 20 On September 30, 2024, 2024, the Magistrate Judge filed findings and recommendations 21 herein which were served on the parties, and which contained notice that the parties may file 22 objections within the time specified therein. (ECF No. 48.) Timely objections to the findings and recommendations have been filed. (ECF No. 49.) 23 24 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C) and Local Rule 304(f), this 25 Court has conducted a *de novo* review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the 26 Court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper 27 analysis. /// 28 1
