ORDER ADOPTING FINDINGS AND
RECOMMENDATIONS AND DISMISSING
ACTION

(Doc. No. 7)

Plaintiff Robert Eugene Rojas is a county jail inmate proceeding *pro se* in this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.

On July 19, 2022, the assigned magistrate judge issued findings and recommendations, recommending that this action be dismissed without prejudice due to plaintiff’s failure to comply with court orders. (Doc. No. 7.) The findings and recommendations were served on plaintiff and contained notice that any objections thereto were to be filed within fourteen (14) days of service. (*Id.* at 1–2.) No objections have been filed and the time to do so has since passed.

In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), this court has conducted a *de novo* review of the case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and proper analysis.
