18	Plaintiff Wesley Elvis Peden, proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis, initiated this civil	
19	action on September 6, 2022. (Doc. No. 1.) This matter was referred to a United States	
20	Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.	
21	On June 12, 2023, the assigned magistrate judge issued findings and recommendation	
22	recommending that this action be dismissed, without leave to amend, because plaintiff's first	
23	amended complaint fails to state a cognizable claim and fails to cure the jurisdictional	
24	deficiencies identified by the magistrate judge in the screening order dated April 14, 2023 (Doc.	
25	No. 3). (Doc. No. 5 at 2–3.) The pending findings and recommendations were served on plaintiff	
26	and contained notice that any objections thereto were to be filed within fourteen (14) days after	
27	service. (Id. at 4.) On June 27, 2023, plaintiff filed objections to the pending findings and	
28	recommendations. (Doc. No. 6.)	

In his objections, plaintiff does not substantively address the findings and recommendations. Rather, plaintiff purports to attack the ethics of the "person responsible for the recommendation to dismiss this case." (Doc. No. 6.) The undersigned will disregard plaintiff's accusations as wholly inappropriate. Plaintiff's objections simply provide no basis upon which to reject the pending findings and recommendations.

In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C), this court has conducted a *de novo* review of the case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, including plaintiff's objections, the court concludes that the findings and recommendations are supported by the record and by proper analysis.

Accordingly:

- 1. The findings and recommendations issued on June 12, 2023 (Doc. No. 5) are adopted in full;
- This action is dismissed due to plaintiff's failure to state a cognizable claim for relief and failure to allege that this court has subject matter jurisdiction over plaintiff's claims; and
- 3. The Clerk of the Court is directed to close this case.
