The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 19 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302. 20 On December 21, 2022, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations herein 21 which were served on Plaintiff and which contained notice to Plaintiff that any objections to the 22 findings and recommendations were to be filed within fourteen days. (ECF No. 12.) Plaintiff has 23 not filed objections to the findings and recommendations. 24 The Court presumes that any findings of fact are correct. See Orand v. United States, 602 F.2d 207, 208 (9th Cir. 1979). The magistrate judge's conclusions of law are reviewed *de novo*. 25 26 See Robbins v. Carey, 481 F.3d 1143, 1147 (9th Cir. 2007) ("[D]eterminations of law by the 27 magistrate judge are reviewed de novo by both the district court and [the appellate] court . . . . "). 28 Having reviewed the file, the court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by 1

1	the record and by the proper analysis.
2	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:
3	1. The Findings and Recommendations filed December 21, 2022, (ECF No. 12) are
4	adopted in full and
5	2. Plaintiff's Motion for a Temporary Restraining Order, (ECF No. 4), is DENIED
6	without prejudice.
