Plaintiff alleges that defendant Watkins failed to permit him to present 18 evidence at a disciplinary hearing in violation of his right to due process. On November 8, 2024, 19 defendant filed a motion to opt out of the post-screening ADR project. Defendant's counsel 20 states that after investigating plaintiff's claim and discussing the case with plaintiff and counsel's 21 supervisor, counsel feels the gap between the parties' valuation of the case is too great and a 22 settlement conference would not be productive at this time. This court finds good cause to grant defendant's motion. 23 24 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 1. Defendant's motion to opt out (ECF No. 28) is granted and the ADR stay of this 25 26 action is lifted; and 27 //// //// 28 1
