Plaintiff has not, however, filed an in forma pauperis affidavit or paid the 18 19 required filing fee of \$350.00 plus the \$52.00 administrative fee. See 28 U.S.C. §§ 1914(a), 20 1915(a). Plaintiff will be provided the opportunity either to submit the appropriate affidavit in 21 support of a request to proceed in forma pauperis or to submit the required fees totaling \$402.00. 22 In accordance with the above, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 1. Plaintiff shall submit, within thirty days from the date of this order, an affidavit in 23 24 support of his request to proceed in forma pauperis on the form provided by the Clerk of Court, 25 or the required fees in the amount of \$402.00; plaintiff's failure to comply with this order will 26 ¹ If leave to file *in forma pauperis* is granted, plaintiff will still be required to pay the 27 filing fee but will be allowed to pay it in installments. Litigants proceeding in forma pauperis are 28 not required to pay the \$52.00 administrative fee.
