TO THE HONORABLE COURT:

Plaintiffs RLC Industries, Inc. and Roseburg Forest Products Co. (collectively "Roseburg"), and Defendant Liberty Insurance Corporation ("Liberty") (collectively "the Parties"), by and through their attorneys of record, enter into the following stipulation for an Order modifying the Court's Scheduling Order (ECF 5) to briefly continue the completion date for expert depositions and the expert discovery cutoff by two weeks.

I. <u>RECITALS.</u>

WHEREAS:

- 1. On April 7, 2023, the Court issued its Initial Pretrial Scheduling Order. (ECF 5).
- 2. On July 11, 2023, the Court issued a Minute Order advising the Parties to submit any request to modify the Court's Initial Pretrial Scheduling Order through a Stipulation and Proposed Order for the Court's consideration. (ECF 25).
- 3. On December 19, 2023, the Court granted Roseburg's and Liberty's request to modify the Initial Pretrial Scheduling Order. (ECF 32). The Order continued the non-expert discovery completion date from January 19, 2024 to May 3, 2024.
- 4. On June 28, 2024, the Court granted the Parties' request to modify expert discovery deadlines. (ECF 66). The Order continued the deadline for initial expert witness disclosures from July 5, 2024 to August 2, 2024 and rebuttal expert disclosures from August 2, 2024 to August 30, 2024. The Parties timely served their initial and rebuttal disclosures, and identified a total of eight (8) retained and non-retained expert witnesses.
- 5. The Court also granted the Parties' request to modify the expert deposition and cutoff deadlines. (ECF 66). The current Order requires the Parties to complete expert depositions by October 25, 2024. The expert discovery cutoff date is November 22, 2024.
- 6. The Parties have scheduled six of the eight depositions to take place before the October 25, 2024 deadline. However, based on the experts' and counsel's availability, two of the expert witnesses are not available for deposition until after October 25, 2024.

2	seek the Court's approval, to extend the deadline to take expert depositions for two weeks
