17	Plaintiff, a former county inmate proceeding pro se, filed this civil rights action under 42	
18	U.S.C. §1983. In July 2023, this court granted plaintiff's motion to proceed in forma pauperis	
19	and, upon screening, found plaintiff alleged no claims for relief cognizable under section 1983.	
20	(ECF No. 5.) The complaint was dismissed with leave to amend.	
21	The court's order was returned by the Postal Service because plaintiff was no longer in	
22	custody and plaintiff had not provided the court with a new address. In December 2023, the cour	
23	dismissed this action without prejudice due to plaintiff's failure to prosecute it. (ECF No. 9.)	
24	Shortly thereafter, plaintiff filed a change of address and asked that the case be reopened. That	
25	request was granted. (ECF No. 14.)
