as an amended complaint in his earlier civil rights action, Mathews v. County of Sacramento, et

al., Case No. 2:23-cv-0922-KJM-DB (E.D. Cal.). Accordingly, the undersigned will order the complaint to be filed in that case as a first amended complaint. The undersigned will screen the first amended complaint in due course. In accordance with the above, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows: 1. The Clerk of Court is directed to file a copy of plaintiff's complaint in the present case as a first amended complaint in Mathews v. County of Sacramento, et al., Case No. 2:23-cv-0922-KJM-DB (E.D. Cal.), the earlier-filed civil rights action. 2. Plaintiff is directed to use the case number 23-cv-0922 for all future filings. 3.
