7	claim against Defendant Wellpath Medical; 4) claim alleging Defendant Hagen	
8	violated Plaintiff's right to adequate medical care when he found Plaintiff's grievances	
9	requesting Adderall unfounded; 5) claim against Defendant Wellpath Medical for	
10	denial of Plaintiff's grievances requesting Adderall; and 6) claims against Defendant	
11	Pillay.	
12	3. This action will proceed on the following claims: (1) violation of Plaintiff's right to	
13	privacy against Defendants Wellpath Medical and Wong; and (2) violation of	
14	Plaintiff's right to adequate medical/mental health care against Defendants Wellpath	
15	Medical, Wong, Roesler, and Nevarez.
