17	agree that on remand, the Commissioner will offer plaintiff the opportunity for a hearing, develop	
18	the record as necessary, and issue a new decision. (Id. at 2.)	
19	Good cause appearing, and pursuant to the parties' stipulation, this case is hereby	
20	remanded to the Commissioner of Social Security for further proceedings consistent with the	
21	terms of the parties' stipulation. The Clerk of the Court is directed to enter final judgment in	
22	favor of plaintiff, and against defendant, reversing the final decision of the Commissioner. In	
23	addition, the pending motion for summary judgment (Doc. No. 12) is hereby denied as having	
24	been rendered moot by this order.
