1	On remand, the Commissioner will further develop the record as necessary, offer	
2	Plaintiff the opportunity for a hearing, and issue a new decision. The parties further request that	
3	the Clerk of the Court be directed to enter a final judgment in favor of Plaintiff, and against	
4	Defendant, reversing the final decision of the Commissioner.
