DIRECTING SERVICE

(ECF No. 2.)

This case was referred to the undersigned pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1), Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 72, and Eastern District of California Local Rule 302(c)(15) and Appx. A subsection (j). Plaintiff Sara Walker requests leave to proceed in forma pauperis (“IFP”) without prepayment of the filing fee under 28 U.S.C. § 1915. (ECF No. 2.) Plaintiff’s affidavit demonstrates an inability to prepay fees and costs or give security for them, and so is GRANTED. The Clerk of Court is directed to issue: (i) a summons for this case pursuant to Rule 3 of the Supplemental Rules for Social Security actions; (ii) the undersigned’s scheduling order for Social Security cases; and (iii) the court’s order regarding consent to the jurisdiction of a magistrate judge.
