STIPULATION TO VOLUNTARY REMAND
 PURSUANT TO SENTENCE FOUR OF
 42 U.S.C. § 405(g) AND TO ENTRY OF
 JUDGMENT; ORDER

19 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED, by and between the parties, through their undersigned
 20 attorneys, and with the approval of the Court, that the Commissioner of Social Security has
 21 agreed to a voluntary remand of this case pursuant to sentence four of 42 U.S.C. § 405(g). The
 22 purpose of the remand is to offer Plaintiff a new decision.
 23

24 On remand, the Commissioner will reevaluate the medical opinions and prior
 25 administrative medical findings, further develop the record as necessary and issue a new
 26 decision. The parties further request that the Clerk of the Court be directed to enter a final
 27 judgment in favor of Plaintiff, and against Defendant, reversing the final decision of the
 28 Commissioner.
