25	the successful complete of Plaintiff's asylum interview. In the event USCIS cancels or		
26	reschedules the interview on Plaintiff's application, the agency will endeavor to reschedule the interview		

within four weeks of the original date.

1	The parties therefore stipulate that the new date for Defendants to file an answer or other	
2	dispositive pleading is May 16, 2025.	The parties further request that all other filing deadlines be
3	similarly extended.
