


1 U.S. Postal Service, and if such plaintiff fails to notify the Court and opposing parties within
2 sixty-three (63) days thereafter of a current address, the Court may dismiss the action without
3 prejudice for failure to prosecute.”

4 The court has considered whether the case should be dismissed or other sanctions imposed
5 based on plaintiff’s failure to update his address. Nevertheless, in light of plaintiff’s pro se status,
6 and the court’s desire to resolve the action on the merits, the court finds it appropriate to grant
7 plaintiff an additional opportunity to update his address.

8 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that within fourteen days of the date of this
9 order, plaintiff shall show cause for his failure to keep the court apprised of his current address;
10 failure to respond to this order will result in dismissal of plaintiff’s claims under L.R. 183(b).
