The court ordered petitioner to show cause why this case 14

should not be dismissed as unexhausted, as it appeared that the petition only contained 15 unexhausted claims. The court also noted that a fully unexhausted federal habeas petition may not be stayed and should be dismissed. See, e.g., Rasberry v. Garcia, 448 F.3d 1150, 1154 (9th Cir. 2006).

Petitioner has not filed a response or otherwise communicated with the court. Therefore, the petition is **DISMISSED** without prejudice as unexhausted. Petitioner may file a new petition once the claims have been exhausted. Because reasonable jurists would not find the result here debatable, a certificate of appealability ("COA") is **DENIED**. See 22 Slack v. McDaniel, 529 U.S. 473, 484-85 (2000) (standard for COA). The clerk shall close the file.
