The Court has received a letter from counsel for plaintiff City of Willits, requesting that the Court vacate the May 6, 2016 hearing set for plaintiffs' motion for order modifying the amended final consent decree, and enter the proposed order without a hearing, in light of the fact that there has been no opposition to the motion.
