15 Before the Court is the parties' "Stipulated Request Pursuant to Local Rule 6-2 for  
16 Order Changing Time for Briefing," filed October 9, 2008, by which the parties seek to  
17 extend the briefing schedule on plaintiff Tegic Communications, Inc.'s ("Tegic") Motion for  
18 an Order to Show Cause Why Defendants Should Not Be Held in Contempt and Motion for  
19 Leave to File said Contempt Motion. Because plaintiffs conditioned said stipulation on  
20 retention of the current hearing date, and because the Court declines to maintain such date  
21 if the briefing schedule is extended, the Court construes the stipulation as a unilateral  
22 request by defendants to extend the date by which their opposition is due.

23 So construed, the request is hereby GRANTED, as follows:

- 24 1. Defendants' opposition shall be due October 17, 2008,  
25 2. Tegic's reply shall be due October 24, 2008,  
26 3. The hearing on plaintiffs' motions is hereby CONTINUED to November 7, 2008.
