26 submitted in the individual *Plata* and *Coleman* cases. Any documents raising specific  
27 medical care concerns shall be forwarded to the *Plata* Receiver's Controlled Correspondence  
28 Unit for appropriate investigation, and any documents raising specific mental health care

1 concerns shall be forwarded to plaintiffs' counsel. All other documents shall be returned to  
2 the inmates with a copy of this order.
