ORDER TO DEPOSIT FUNDS

To ensure that sufficient funds remain on deposit in the Court’s registry to pay court expert expenses, and given Defendants’ inability to make deposits by wire and the Court’s finance procedures governing waiting periods on paper check deposits, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Defendants shall deposit an additional \$300,000 into the Court’s registry within forty-five days of the date of this order.
