See Docket No. 649. North Pacifica 17 initially opposed the request because it had not yet decided at the time whether to file a petition for 18 writ of certiorari with the Supreme Court. North Pacifica, however, has now orally informed the 19 Court that it is not pursuing such a petition. Accordingly, North Pacifica does not oppose the release 20 of the City's deposit. See Opp'n at 2 ("If a decision is made not to pursue a petition for writ of 21 certiorari to the U.S. Supreme Court, North Pacifica will stipulate to the release of the City's 22 deposit."). Taking into account all of the circumstances, including North Pacifica's lack of 23 opposition, the Court hereby **GRANTS** Defendants' application. The Court orders the Clerk of the 24 Court to refund the deposit to the City. 25 IT IS SO ORDERED. 26 Dated: September 29, 2008
