ORDER AMENDING ORDER DIRECTING CLERK TO DISBURSE INTERPLED FUNDS TO EDWARD ALVARADO AND CHARLOTTE BOSWELL

In an order filed December 19, 2011, the Court directed the Clerk of the Court to immediately disburse the previously interpled funds (\$178,246.03 plus accrued interest for Mr. Alvarado, and $\$ 328,304.85$ plus accrued interest for Ms. Boswell).
