g considered that report, Plaintiff is HEREBY ORDERED TO SHOW CAUSE as to why this case should not be dismissed for failure to prosecute and why sanctions should not be imposed. Plaintiff's response to this Order to Show Cause shall be due by no later than February 17, 2010. Defendants may submit a brief in opposition to Plaintiff's response by no later than February 25, 2010, if they believe an opposition is necessary. It is FURTHER ORDERED that this matter will be set down for a hearing on this Order to Show Cause on March 5, 2010 at 1:30 p.m. Plaintiff shall be present for this hearing. If Plaintiff is unable to be present on that date, the parties shall meet and confer and submit a stipulation and proposed order continuing the hearing to a Friday afternoon in March when Plaintiff is available to be personally present for the hearing. A continuance of the hearing on the Order to Show Cause shall not alter the briefing deadlines set by this Order.
