15 Plaintiff may submit an application and order to speak with a possible new witness.

16 This case shall be reassigned to Magistrate-Judge Vadas (from Mag. Laporte) for settlement purposes. The settlement conference shall occur during the first 1/2 of April 2009.

17 The pretrial conference **SHALL** be attended by trial counsel prepared to discuss all aspects of the case, including settlement. Parties **SHALL** conform to the attached instructions. Plaintiff is ORDERED to serve a copy of this order on any party subsequently joined in this action.
