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1 Following this Court's award of attorneys' fees, the United States appealed. On
2 March 19, 2010, the Ninth Circuit vacated and remanded with instructions. The Ninth
3 Circuit's memorandum was filed in this court on April 2, 2010, and the mandate issued on
4 April 12, 2010.

5 The objective of the United States, joined by Eurofed, is to resolve the matter of the
6 amount of attorneys' fees owed Eurofed, and to do so as quickly and as cost-effectively as
7 possible. To that end, the parties suggest the following schedule:

- 8 1. The parties agree, subject to the Court's approval, that the case management
9 conference scheduled for April 30, 2010 at 8:30 a.m. be taken off calendar and
10 rescheduled, if necessary, after the parties have completed the process below.
- 11 2. On or before April 28, 2010, Eurofed will provide to the United States the
12 time-date-task information underlying its application for attorneys' fees for
13 \$289,463.75, and underlying time-date-task information for whatever
14 additional fees Eurofed seeks payment since the date of the original
15 submission.
- 16 3. On or before May 12, 2010, the United States will, after having reviewed
17 Eurofed's the time-date-task information, respond and make an offer to
18 resolve the attorneys' fees request. The United States reserves its right to
19 object to any of Eurofed's claimed fees.
- 20 4. On or before May 19, 2010, Eurofed will respond to that offer.
- 21 5. On or before May 26, 2010, the parties will meet and confer regarding
22 whether there are any remaining issues and, if so, what the best and most cost
23 effective way is to resolving them, including mediation with a Magistrate
24 Judge. The parties will either file a settlement agreement, ask the Court to

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assign them to a Magistrate Judge for mediation, or suggest some other reasonable way of resolving any remaining issues.
