22 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED by and between Plaintiff Liliana Solis and the class she
23 represents ("Plaintiffs") and Defendants The Regis Corporation and Supercuts Corporate Shops
24 ("Defendants") through their respective counsel of record, that the Further Case Management
25 Conference set for September 19, 2008 at 8:30 a.m. be continued for 30 days. The parties are
26 diligently working on a settlement agreement, and anticipate that they will be able to have it
27 completed and finalized within 30 days of the September 19, 2008 Further Case Management
28 Conference Date.

The continuance of the Further Case Management Conference is warranted because
counsel have been unable to complete the settlement agreement and proposed notice. Counsel
have been in communication and exchanged information about details of pay practices for

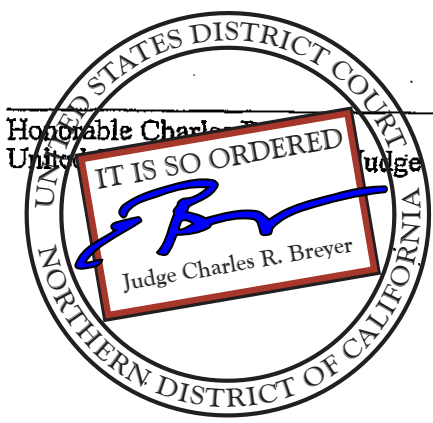
