Before the Court are defendant’s “Status Conference Report,” filed February 13, 2009, and plaintiff’s “Status Report,” filed February 17, 2009. Defendant, in its report, states that although the arbitrator in the related labor arbitration has issued a “further decision,” the parties have not yet had the opportunity to review such decision to determine, *inter alia*, “what issues will remain in dispute for this civil action.” (See Def.’s Rep. at 2:13-17.) Defendant further states that the parties request a continuance of the Case Management Conference in the instant action to a date in April 2009. Plaintiff, in his report, states he “fully agree[s]” with the statements made in defendant’s report. (See Pl.’s Rep. at 1:23.)


