## 

Pursuant to Northern District of California Local Rule 7-11 and 7-12, Apple hereby moves to increase the page limit for its reply brief in support of its Motion for Summary Judgment of Invalidity from 15 pages to 18 pages. Northern District of California Civil Local Rule 7-3(c) states that reply briefs or memoranda may not exceed fifteen pages of text. Apple requests this Court increase the page limit by three pages, from 15 pages to 18 pages. Burst.com, Inc. does not oppose this request. A stipulation to that effect is attached hereto. The increase in the page limit is warranted because Burst does not oppose the request, because the requested increase is small (3 pages), because the Court issued its claim construction order after Apple filed its motion, and because the motion addresses two prior art references and 11 claims.
