1 The United States has administratively moved, pursuant to Civil Local Rule 7-11, for an
2 order allowing (1) the Memorandum Of The United States In Support Of The Military And State
3 Secrets Privilege And Motion To Dismiss Or, In The Alternative, For Summary, and (2) the
4 Memorandum Of The United States In Support Of The Military And State Secrets Privilege And
5 Motion To Dismiss Or, In The Alternative, For Summary Judgment, to exceed the 25 page limit.

6 The Court, having considered the United States' motion and there being no opposition by
7 the parties thereto, and good cause appearing,

8 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 9 1. The United States' motion is hereby granted;
- 10 2. The Memorandum Of The United States In Support Of The Military And State

16 filed in the length of that memorandum.
