



HOW HITLER'S NAZI FLAG IS VEILED IN A MASONIC LODGE

Pages 66 and my next page 67 are used to illustrate how Hitler's Nazi flag is a part of and is veiled in all Masonic Lodges. We will use Questions and Answers from GENERAL TEST # 18 that are duplicated here from "1000 POINTS OF LIGHT", to describe and locate the Nazi Swastika and Flag hidden on the document on page 67.



If you recalled the figure of the 47th problem is the Swastika which has four (4) seven-(7)-like figures forming 4 inner squares, and one large outer square. The 4 inner squares are equal to the one outer square which are the two blocks in front of the green circle on page 67. Question #14 ask what are the length of the wands of our three ancient Grand Masters. These are the three deities represented by three purple cubes on page 67. The Answer for 14 says these are 3,4, and 5 units in length respectively. These lengths are the lengths of the three cubes which has 3, 4, and 5 squares in length. I have cut these and illustrated them above separately. Question #s'15 and 17 are continuations of questions about these cubes which are veils for the Swastika. #15 ask when placed in juxtaposition (side-by-side), what figure did they form? The Answer is a right-angled triangle, contents 6. This right-angled triangle can be seen in the shaded area in the middle of the cubes on page 67. I have illustrated above how the right-angled triangle is formed on the Swastika. Questions # 17 which refers specifically to the three squares of the 47th problem, ask the total of the contents. The answer is 50. 9 squares on the smaller cube. 16 squares on the mid-size cube. And twenty-five squares on the larger cube. Their total sum is 50. The sum of the two smaller ones 9 + 16 is 25. These 25 are equal to the sum of the larger one which is 25. The working tools all gathered inside the symbol of the swastika symbolizes that the Swastika is the working tool of Masonry. The shoe at the bottom who's heel is on a yellow rope are the words of Genesis 3: 15 converted into complex symbolism. "IT SHALL BRUISE THOU HEAD, AND THOU SHALL BRUISE HIS HEEL". The yellow Star before the altar, and the yellow rope, are both emblems of SATAN. So is the yellow square in the green circle which symbolizes the Nazi flag of Hitler. Remember that these three cubes represents the Triple-Tau for the 3 Masonic deities. The bible is opened to the 133 Psalms which are the Psalms of the Degrees (Masons). See page 11 for the Cover of LIFE Magazine where the red, yellow and blue man representing all of Masonry 3 deities in one, is placed in one giant cube. (Important Point).

ILLUSTRATING THE SIGNIFICANCE OF THE NUMBERS 9 AND 3 IN MASONRY

Answer number 9 and 11 below is duplicated to show the significance of these numbers in Masonry. All answers are coded, and do not represent the deeper meaning in Masonic teachings and doctrines. These are never printed, but only taught in the Lodges.

The number 3 represents the three deities of Masonry corresponding to the triple crosses. These deities are represented secretly by placing three dots . . . in a triangular form. On the back side of this EXHIBIT "F" they are mentioned in Question and Answer number 10'. The first one is called the "Vulgar Era, year of their lord". He is called "VULCAN". This VULCAN appears in Question and Answer #1 for General Test #1 which is my "EXHIBIT 'D'". He is described as one who was expelled from heaven, and was 9 days in falling. He is represented in Masonry by the Red X which corresponds to "V" in the INTERNATIONAL ALPHABET FLAG CODE. This "V" stands for VULCAN. He is veiled in Masonry as TUBAL CAIN. See General Test #17, Questions and Answers #s 19, and 20 which is my EXHIBIT "C". This Tau X is also symbolic for "TUBAL". This deity who is Satan, places the X as two ones (11) inside of his initial "S" as a dollar sign, or September 11. It is a mystery which says, "NO MAN CAN BUY, SELL, OR TRADE WITHOUT THIS MARK". Remember that the nine-pointed star of the 33° represents the number of days Satan was falling. As shown below, the 33 is 3 x 3 which equals 9 for the number of days fallin



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



ANTHRAX, *AN thraks*, is a severe infectious disease of human beings and of many animals. It is caused by a bacterium, the *Bacillus anthracis*. In people, the disease often starts as a carbuncle in the skin. But the germs also may be inhaled and infect the lungs. Human beings get the disease by exposure to an infected animal or to animal products. Persons commonly infected are butchers, farmers, sheepherders, wool handlers, and veterinarians. Laws that govern the handling of animal

products have reduced anthrax incidence in people. Animals with anthrax have chills, fever, dysentery, and convulsions. They die suddenly. Animals contract the disease by eating contaminated food. Anthrax can ruin livestock raising. Veterinarians vaccinate livestock against the disease. Farmers burn or bury infected carcasses and remove well animals from areas that have become infected.



Some historians believe that anthrax was the Fifth Plague of Egypt mentioned in the Bible. The anthrax bacterium was first seen by French scientist Casimir Davaine in 1850. In 1876, Robert Koch, a German physician, established that it caused anthrax. Thus it became the first germ known to cause disease, and helped prove Koch's germ theory. Louis Pasteur developed anthrax vaccine.
