27	hereby REFERS Defendants' Motion, as well as all future motions

shall issue recommendations and tentative rulings on the motions. These recommendations will be subject to the Court's final approval. See Order $\P\P$ 16-19. The parties shall continue to file their papers in the Court's electronic filing system, but chambers copies shall be directed to Judge Larson rather than to this Court. The hearing on Defendants' Motion, scheduled to be held before this Court on October 5, is hereby VACATED.
