CORRECTION OF CIVIL PRETRIAL  
MINUTES**

1 Plaintiffs file this Motion for Administrative Relief to correct what may be two ministerial  
2 errors in the Civil Pretrial Minutes, filed December 11, 2007 (Doc 161), regarding the status  
3 conference held on December 10, 2007. Pursuant to Civil Local Rule 7-11(a), Defendant has  
4 stipulated to this motion.

5 First, the Minutes suggest that the Court ordered a two-year statute of limitations period for  
6 this case. However, counsel for the parties understood that the Court did not reach any final  
7 decision on the statute of limitations period. Rather, after a brief discussion of the issue as well as  
8 the possible different analyses that could apply to the different causes of action, the Court deferred  
9 a ruling on the statute of limitations and directed the parties to modify the class notice to state:  
10 "All Legally Blind Individuals Who Have Attempted to Access Target.com Since February 7,  
11 2003, may have a claim as described below."

12 Additionally, the Civil Pretrial Minutes state that the class notice is to be posted by  
13 December 21, 2007. However, counsel understood that this deadline was for filing the final  
14 version of the proposed class notice with the Court. It is counsels' understanding that, after this  
15 filing, the Court will then review the notice and, assuming the Court does not have further changes,  
16 will approve it for posting by a date promptly thereafter.

17 Accordingly, Plaintiffs respectfully request that the Civil Pretrial Minutes be modified  
18 accordingly. Defendant has stipulated to this motion.
