- 11 k. Yahoo! Inc.

12 2. The parties have conferred about the schedule for the Netflix
 13 Motions and have agreed as follows.

14 3. Netflix has agreed to Blockbuster's request that the Court's
 15 hearing on the Netflix Motions be scheduled for November 17, 2006.

16 4. In return, Blockbuster has agreed to inform the third-parties
 17 listed above that they are not required to produce documents in response to the
 18 Subject Subpoenas until ten business days after this Court rules on the Netflix's
 19 Motions.

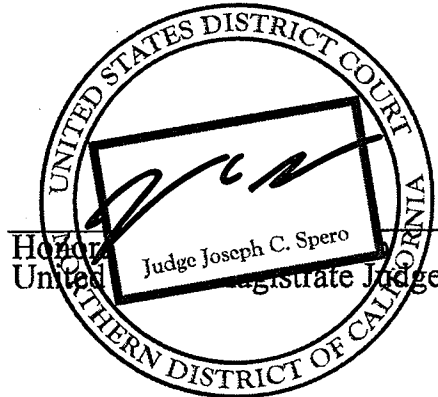
