

On January 23, 2009, defendants filed opposition to plaintiff's motion for attorneys' 17 fees and non-taxable costs. Defendants have violated General Order 45 and the Court's 18 19 Standing Orders, however, by failing to deliver to the Clerk's Office "no later than noon on 20 the business day following the day that the papers are filed electronically, one paper copy 21 of each document that is filed electronically . . . marked 'Chambers Copy' and . . . clearly marked with the judge's name, case number, and 'Chambers Copy-Do Not File." See 22 23 General Order 45 § VI.G; see also Standing Orders For Civil Cases Assigned to The 24 Honorable Maxine M. Chesney ¶ 2.

Defendants are hereby ORDERED to comply with General Order 45 and the Court's
Standing Orders by immediately submitting a chambers copy of the above-referenced
document. Defendants are hereby advised that if they fail in the future to comply with
General Order 45 and the Court's Standing Order to provide chambers copies of

1	electronically-filed documents, the Court may impose sanctions, including, but not limited
2	to, striking from the record any electronically-filed document of which a chambers copy has
3	not been timely provided to the Court.
