25 Defendants are hereby ORDERED to comply with General Order 45 and the Court's
26 Standing Orders by immediately submitting a chambers copy of the above-referenced
27 document. Defendants are hereby advised that if they fail in the future to comply with
28 General Order 45 and the Court's Standing Order to provide chambers copies of

1 electronically-filed documents, the Court may impose sanctions, including, but not limited
2 to, striking from the record any electronically-filed document of which a chambers copy has
3 not been timely provided to the Court.
