1 On August 13, 2010, the parties informed the Court they had reached settlement following
2 mediation. At the request and joint stipulation of the parties, the Court re-scheduled the status
3 conference, originally set for September 3, 2010, to September 17, 2010 at 1:30 pm.

4 The parties are continuing to work diligently and in good faith to finalize the terms of the
5 settlement agreement and accompanying documentation. The parties agree on the basic
6 provisions of the agreement, however, the process is taking longer than the parties anticipated
7 because of the technology rights aspect of the settlement. Any disposition of the technology
8 rights requires the consent and approval from a third party. The third party has been contacted
9 and the parties believe that they will be able to finalize the settlement documents by mid-October
10 2010. Accordingly, the parties respectfully ask the Court to continue the status conference for at
11 least thirty days, to October 22, 2010.




