14 Respondent has filed two ex parte applications for an extension of time to respond to the
15 petition for writ of habeas corpus. Having considered the applications and the accompanying
16 declarations of attorney Jeremy Friedlander, the court GRANTS respondent's applications.
17 (Docket # 40, 43.) Respondent must file and serve his answer to the petition for writ of habeas
18 corpus no later than **March 6, 2009**. Petitioner must file and serve his traverse no later than
19 **April 10, 2009**.

20 Petitioner's two motions for an evidentiary hearing are DENIED. (Docket # 41, # 42.)
21 If, after the petition is fully briefed on the merits, the court determines that an evidentiary
22 hearing is necessary it will order one sua sponte.
