Now pending before the Court is the motion of John Werner to withdraw as counsel for the above plaintiff in the above action. After carefully considering the motion and the declaration filed under seal therewith, the Court **ORDERS PLAINTIFF TO SHOW CAUSE** as to why (1) counsel’s motion to withdraw as counsel of record should not be granted; and (2) Plaintiff’s lawsuit should not be dismissed for a lack of prosecution. See Fed. R. Civ. P. 41. If Plaintiff wishes to contest the withdrawal of counsel and/or dismissal of Plaintiff’s lawsuit for failure to prosecute, Plaintiff shall notify the Court **in writing** on or before **November 18, 2009** of the reasons the withdrawal should not be granted or the case dismissed. If Plaintiff will be proceeding without a lawyer, Plaintiff must advise the Court of how the Court should contact Plaintiff.

Plaintiff is warned that Plaintiff’s failure to communicate with the Court in writing as

1 set forth above may result in dismissal of Plaintiff's claims with prejudice.

2 Plaintiff's counsel shall ensure that Plaintiff receives a copy of this Order.
