20 1. On July 23, 2010, a status conference was held on the above-captioned matter before
 21 the Honorable Susan Illston, United States District Judge. At that court appearance, the setting of a
 22 trial date was discussed but a trial date was not set;

23 2. Both counsel agreed that the time between July 23, 2010 and August 6, 2010 should be
 24 excluded pursuant to 18 U.S.C. §§ 3161(h)(7)(A) and (B)(i) & (ii);

25 Based upon the representations made by the parties in open court on July 23, 2010, the
 26 Court's request that the government submit a proposed order, and good cause appearing therefor,

1 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the time between July 23, 2010 and August 6, 2010 shall
2 be excluded from the computation of the period within which the trial must commence, for the
3 reasons and based upon the statutory provisions set forth above, and for those reasons proffered by
4 the parties in open court. Based upon the grounds set forth above, the Court finds that the ends of
5 justice outweigh the interests of the public and the parties in a speedier trial, and that failure to grant
6 such a continuance would likely result in a miscarriage of justice.
